Madagascar - "Medium" scale request (1987)

The Secretariat has recently received a request for a financial contribution of US\$25,000 towards costs associated with a workshop to be held at Mananara Nord for 20 to 30 September 1987 with a view to launching an exemplary integrated conservation project involving local populations in the region. Support from the World Heritage Fund would be used to defray logistic organization costs and the travel and subsistence of three international experts who will stay on in Madagascar for several months to help with the launching of the integrated conservation project as well as to advise on protective measures for the Morondava-Belo sur Tsiribinina area, which has been identified as a potential natural World Heritage property.
