Tentative lists of cultural and natural properties received since the twelfth session of the World Heritage Committee

- 1. Since the twelfth session of the Committee, the Secretariat has received tentative lists of cultural properties from Colombia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Luxemburg and Thailand. A tentative list of cultural and natural properties was also received from Tanzania. This brings the number of States parties having submitted tentative lists to 44 (see Annex 1).
- 2. Two States (France and Spain) also submitted a revised tentative list of their cultural properties.
- 3. The tentative lists received since the twelfth session of the Committee will be at the disposal of the Bureau members for consultation.
