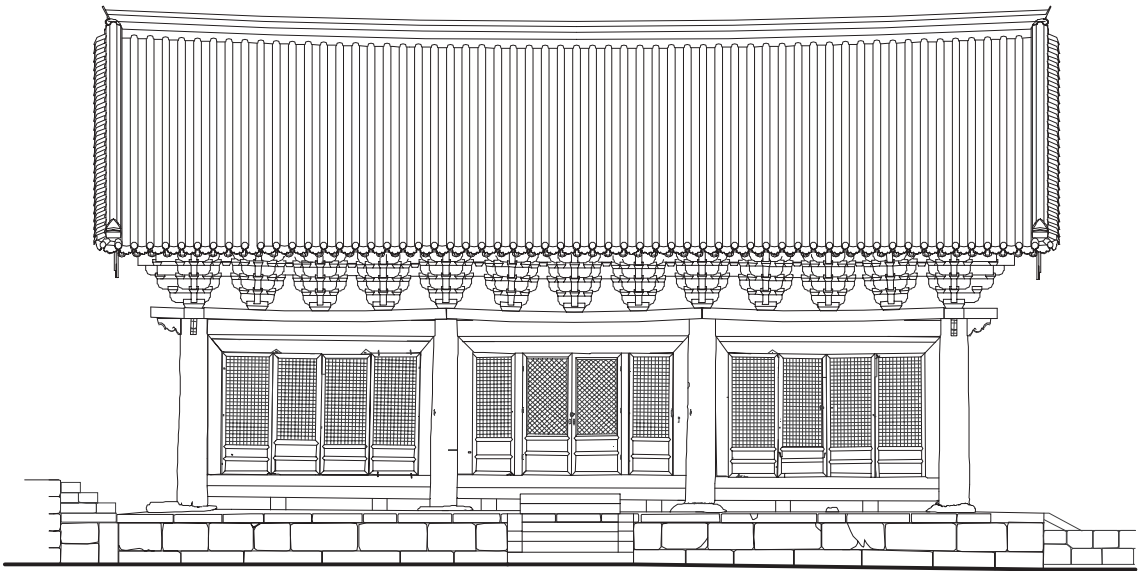
# 1 - 5 Vulture Peak Hall

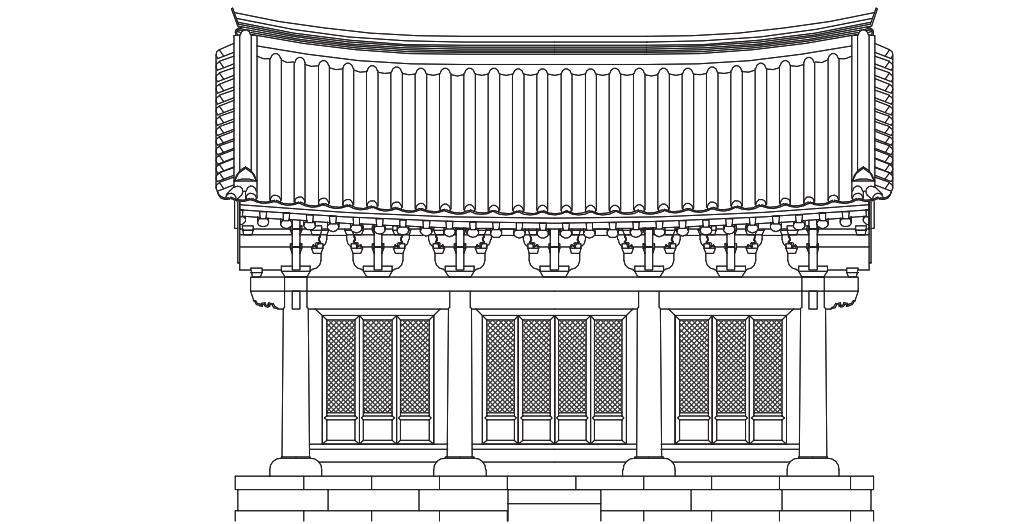


# 1 - 8 Shrine of Mountain Spirits

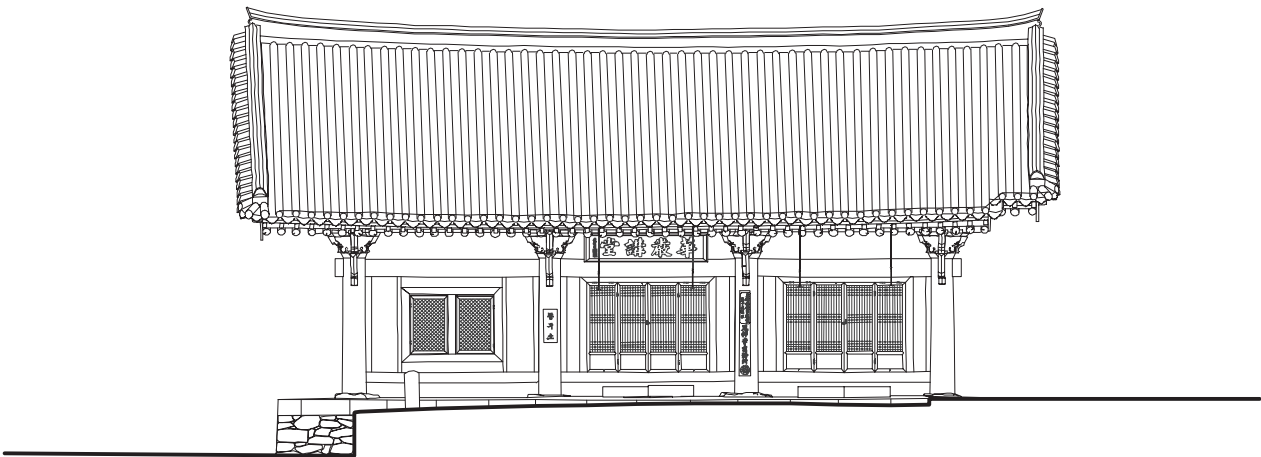


3-5 Avatamsaka Lecture Hall

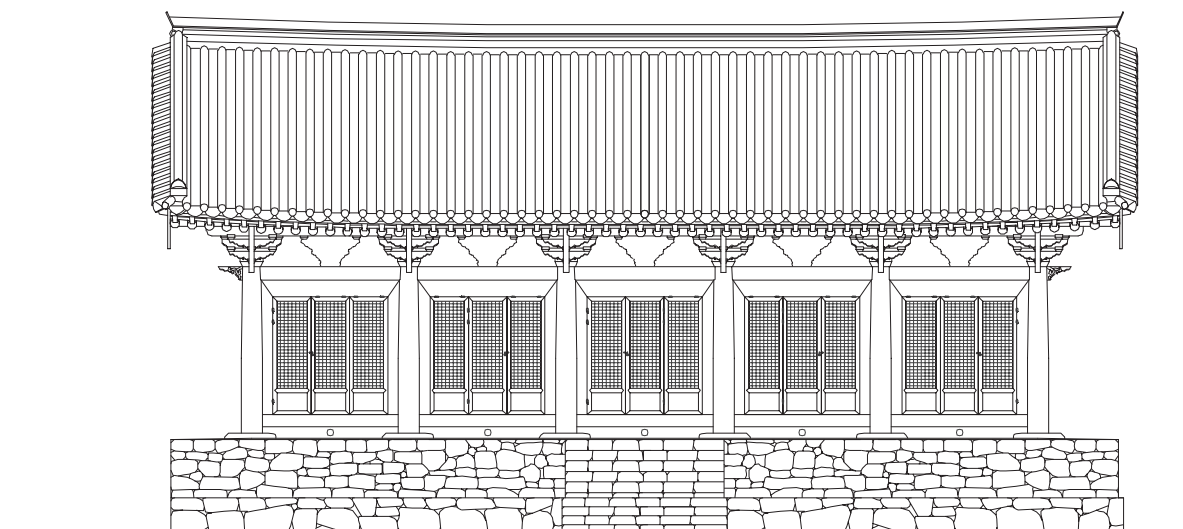
5-4 Vulture Peak Hall

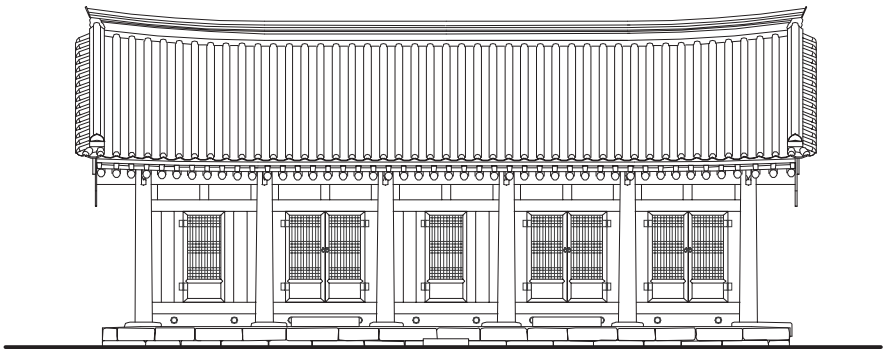


7-2 Hall of Arhats · Shrine of Mountain Spirits

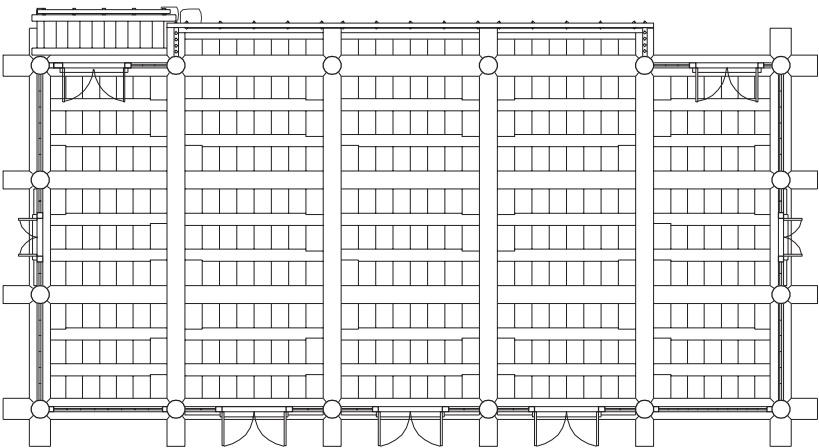

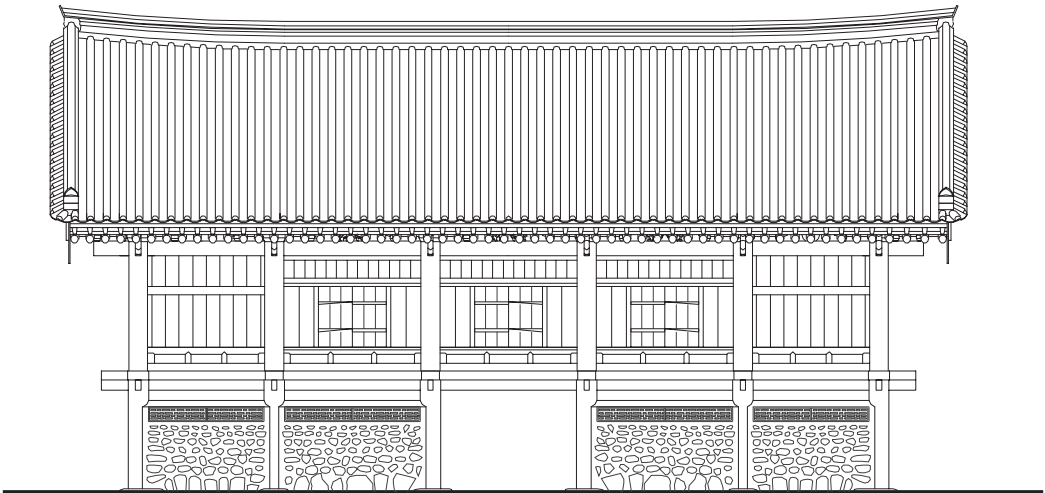


7-3 Pillow Pavilion

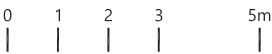
