Item 9 of the Provisional Agenda: Requests for technical cooperation

COSTA RICA (Request No. 205.1 (Rev. 2)

Financial contribution towards training programmes, improvement of infrastructure, transportation and purchase of equipment for the Talamanca Range-La Amistad Reserve Complex (nominated for inclusion in the World Heritage List) amounting to \$30,000. The request can be broken down into \$5,000 for training activities and \$25,000 for technical cooperation.

IVORY COAST

- Request No. 195.1 (Rev.)

Financial contribution to the construction of a wardens' station, purchase of fuel for research activities and provision of a vehicle for Tai National Park, amounting to \$30,000.

- Request No. 257.1

Vehicles and financial assistance for the construction of guard posts and various buildings, delimitation of boundaries and well-boring at Mount Nimba (Ivory Coast part) at a cost of \$220,000.

ETHIOPIA (Request No. 9.1(3)

Equipment for the environmental education programme in Simen National Park and surrounding rural area of the Simen Mountains, at a cost of \$45,000.

HAITI (Request No. 180.1)

Financial support towards masonry work and purchase of equipment for the restoration of the Citadel Henry National History Park amounting to \$24,930.

HONDURAS

- Request No. 129.1

Equipment, consultant services and support to training activities for the conservation and development of the Maya Ruins of Copan, at a cost of \$47,000. This sum includes \$26,850 for training activities.

- Request No. 196.1 (Rev. 2)

Financial assistance for the implementation of protective measures, for training activities and environmental education programmes for Rio Platano Biosphere Reserve, amounting to \$21,395 (\$15,475 for technical cooperation and \$5,920 for training activities).

JORDAN (HACHEMITE KINGDOM OF) (Request No. 148.1)

Consultant services to undertake an architectural survey of monuments of the Old City of Jerusalem which are in need of restoration and to prepare a plan for the preservation work to be undertaken, at a cost of US\$60,000.

NEPAL (Request No. 120.1(4)

Financial contribution towards the reafforestation programme, improvement of the displays at the visitors' centre and provision of a small electric pump for Sagarmatha National Park, at a cost of \$30,000.

PANAMA (Request No. 159.1 (Rev. 2)

Services of specialists and field equipment for Darien National Park at a cost of \$25,000.

POLAND (Request No. 32.1)

Equipment for preparatory work, safeguarding activities and security measures in the Wieliczka Salt Mine, at a cost of \$95,500.
