

### The core zone is subjected to the following rules:

- 1. No allocation is permitted, constructions, digging wells or subterranean canals, tree plantations, excavations, earth filling or civil engineering operations are strictly prohibited.
- 2. The Iranian Cultural Heritage and Tourism organization (ICHTII) leads restoration works, archaeological excavations and investigations. It may proceed to the establishment of the necessary installations

#### The buffer zone is subject to the following rules:

- 1. It is permitted to cary out traditional farming in existing farms and agricultural lands within their boundaries at surface level.
- 2. In the event of need to set up installations such as electricity posts, etc. along the roads which cross the buffer zone, ICHTO's permission must requested.

#### The landscape buffer zone is subject to the following rules:

- It is permitted to continue to carry out agricultural or gardenig activites.
- 2 Industrial installations causing environmental pollution, mining, or any activities altering the structure of the mountains or damaging the general landscape is forbidden.

## The expansion zones of the villages are subjected to the following rules:

- 1. Enclaves are allocated to future expansions of villages.
- 2. It is highly recommended that all constructions in the expansion areas be carried out in respect to local traditional architecture.
