Following Decision **34 COM 16**, paragraphs 9 & 10, US\$40,000 and US\$83,000 were taken from the International Assistance budget (originally US\$800,000) to cover respectively the costs of the external audit on Global Strategy and of the review of Statements of OUV for Asia-Pacific region.

In September 2008, Italy made available an amount of 250,000 EUR (equivalent to US\$357,348) for International Assistance requests, to allow approval of requests in case the International Assistance budget was insufficient. In 2010-2011, US\$134,058 were approved against this funding source (4.5 Preparatory Assistance requests plus 2 Emergency Assistance requests), which leaves US\$223,290 available for other requests (see details on p.7-8 of this document).
