## Item 7 of the Provisional Agenda: Elections to the World Heritage Committee.

1. As at the end of the 22nd session of the General Conference, the World Heritage Committee was composed of the following twenty-one States Parties:

Algeria	Guinea	Pakistan
Argentina	Italy	Panama
Australia	Jordan	Senegal
Brazil	Lebanon	Sri Lanka
Cyprus	Lib <b>yan Arab Jamahiriya</b>	Switzerland
France	Malavi	Turkey
Germany, Fed. Rep. of	Norway	Zaïre

2. The terms of office of the above-mentioned twenty-one members extend as follows:

- until the end of the 23rd session of the General Conference of Unesco (1985):

Argentina, France, Italy, Pakistan, Panama, Senegal, Switzerland;

- until the end of the 24th session of the General Conference of Unesco (1987):

Brazil, Cyprus, Germany (Fed. Rep. of), Guinea, Jordan, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Zaïre;

- until the end of the 25th session of the General Conference of Unesco (1989):

Algeria, Australia, Lebanon, Malawi, Norway, Sri Lanka, Turkey.

3. The fifth General Assembly is called upon to elect seven members to the World Heritage Committee to replace those members whose term of office expires at the end of the 23rd session of the General Conference.

In this connection, it will be recalled that paragraph 5 of Article 16 of the Convention provides that "Any State Party to the Convention which is in arrears with the payment of its compulsory or voluntary contribution for the current year and the calendar year immediately preceding it shall not be eligible as a Nember of the World Heritage Committee... The terms of office of any such State which is already a member of the Committee shall terminate at the time of the elections provided for in Article 8, paragraph 1 of this Convention". A statement on compulsory and voluntary contributions as at 31 July 1985 appears in document CLT-85/CONF.009/2, Annex III. The General Assembly will be informed on 4 November 1985 of any compulsory or voluntary contributions received since 31 July 1985.
