



and many animals.





But one day some lumber men in the village started felling down trees without replanting them.




Since the rain fell very heavily and no tree to block the heavy rain, it destroyed houses.



Four months later, the rainy season came.




Because there was lesser trees the animals also went to another village.




The villagers carried some of their belongings and went to a nearby village.
