SUMMARY

Section B(c) of the Authorization procedure for the use of the World Heritage Emblem, contained in the Guidelines and Principles for the use of the World Heritage Emblem (Annex 3 of the Operational Guidelines), stipulates that the Director of the World Heritage Centre has the authority to grant the use of the Emblem in accordance with the said Guidelines and Principles.

The same article refers to a yearly report on authorized uses of the Emblem to be submitted to the Committee.

The information contained in this information document is a report of projects examined by the Centre for which the use of the World Heritage Emblem was granted in 2001 and 2002.
