Mégalithiques de Saa, Cameroon

Site inscribed on a Tentative List since 2006

13/03/2016 - 09/04/2016



Located 15 km from the city of Ngambé, megaliths Saa Limbum Language belong to the community. There are two groups of megaliths located in an epicenter of 3 and 4 km from the village of Saa. The first group is Saa - Mbura and covers an area of one square kilometer. The second group is Saa – Machub. They are standing stones, arranged either in a circle or square and sometimes aligned. As associated element, there are circular platforms, monoliths and millstones. Despite the unavailability of accurate dating of comparisons with known site such as tazunu the CAR northwest may allow us to assume that these sites date back to a period before the Christian era.

Project objectives: This project aims to help the rehabilitation of two groups of the monoliths of the site. It also aims to create and archive the records so it can be far easier to access the information about the site. The project also targets to implement a digitalization for the information in order to promote the site to visit with modernized management and marketing tool.

Project activities: The volunteers will be involved in all rehabilitation activities such as removal of weed, maintenance and cleaning the site. The volunteers, together with the project managers, will work on gathering and digitizing historical information of the site and will help to increase the visibility of the site by implementing a 3D online visit of two monoliths and promoting on the social networks.

Partners: Social Entrepreneurs Club, the traditional chiefs of the villages, and the company 3s3i (LLC).
