1. ANALYTICAL SUMMARY OF THE REPORT.

The Plurinational State of Bolivia established important advances in 2017 management thanks to the Technical Assistance of UNESCO experts. The participation of local, regional and central level institutions was unsurpassable and allowed the elaboration of the Document: *Desired State of Conservation for the taking off the City of Potosí from the List of World Heritage in Danger - DSOCR*, which points to four fields of action within the UNESCO declaration, which are: Productive Mining Heritage, Environmental, Archaeological, Architectural and Urban Heritage, and the Management and Governance Systems.

The actions in relation to the clarification of limits and definition of the Buffer Zone for the Site are progressing according to the commitment agreement and are under the responsibility of the Autonomous Departmental Government of Potosí, this work will be delivered soon as established.

The strategy for the development of the Comprehensive and Participatory Management Plan has progress in three actions:

1. Socialization of the Content Script for the Management Plan that was sent to the participating entities.
2. Delivery of the formats of the objectives, Public Policies and indicators.
3. Delivery of formats of descriptive file cards for projects and programs.

The information is not yet collected in its entirety, but there is an important progress process, in this sense for the month of March 2018 will have the systematization of it.

In terms of Legislation to address the Conservation and Preservation of Cerro Rico, the Ministry of Mining and Metallurgy has prepared a draft Supreme Decree that defines mechanisms and legal instruments for the conservation of the morphological structure of Cerro Rico de Potosí, it is still in analysis by the instance of social and economic policies of the Bolivian State.

The proposed calendar for the implementation of the corrective measures is adequate and flexible, which is why deadlines are being met.
