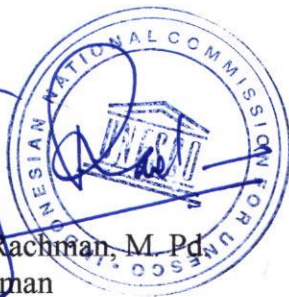

Sangiran Early Man Site (Indonesia) (C593)

1. Executive Summary of the report

This report, addressed to the World Heritage Centre, is in response to the request made in Paragraph 5 of WHC Decision 42 COM 7B.8 (2018) of an updated report on the state of conservation of the property and the implementation of the above, for examination by the World Heritage Committee at its 44th session in 2020, for the improved safeguarding of the Sangiran Early Man Site (C 593). Altogether there were two (2) recommendations contained in the aforesaid Decision of the Committee, viz:

DECISION PARA 3

- i. to ensure that the new management entity, Memoranda of Understanding and Cooperation Agreements are established as soon as possible, to guarantee an adequate protection framework

DECISION PARA 4

- ii. to continuously monitor the implementation of regulations to control infrastructural and physical developments within the property, and to ensure the full participation of local communities and residents in its operation

The report consists of a narrative explaining the progress made in the implementation of the measures taken by the Republic of Indonesia (the State Party) to address each of the two specific issues enumerated in Decision 42 COM 7B.8. For ease of reference the Committee Decision 42 COM 7B.8 is reproduced as Annex A, attached to this report.

The narrative report on progress made in the implementation of each of the two issues arising from Decision 42 COM 7B.8 is supported and supplemented by a variety of annexes table of supporting documents, both for ease of reference and to ensure the completeness of this report.

In order to ensure the protection, preservation and conservation of the Sangiran Early Man Site, a Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation of Agreements have been issued through several stakeholder meetings. The completion of 2017 Management Plan signifies that the operation of the new integrated management structure of the Sangiran Early Man Site is on the right track. The awareness and involvement of people living within the Site are reflected by their comprehension on the procedure of developing new buildings and land use. Sangiran Conservation Office is tasked to control and monitor the matters.

2. Response to the Decision of the World Heritage Committee

This report has been made in response to concerns expressed by the committee over a number of requests to review the State of Conservation of Sangiran Early Man Site, Indonesia. Following a detailed discussion at the 42nd Session in Manama, Bahrain (2018), the World Heritage Committee took the following decisions:

Committee Decisions 42 COM 7B.8 Sangiran Early Man Site (C 593) (Indonesia)

The World Heritage Committee,

1. Having examined Document WHC/18/42.COM/7B,
2. Recalling Decision 40 COM 7B.36, adopted at its 40th session (Istanbul/UNESCO, 2016),
3. Acknowledges the completion of the 2017 Sangiran Early Man Site Management Plan and requests the State Party to ensure that the new management entity, Memoranda of Understanding and Cooperation Agreements are established as soon as possible, to guarantee an adequate protection framework;
4. Encourages the State Party to continuously monitor the implementation of regulations to control infrastructural and physical developments within the property, and to ensure the full participation of local communities and residents in its operation;
5. Also requests the State Party to submit to the World Heritage Centre, by 1 December 2019, an updated report on the state of conservation of the property and the implementation of the above for review by the Advisory Bodies.

	<p>In order to ensure the protection, preservation and conservation of the Sangiran Early Man Site, a Memorandum of Understanding on the Protection, Development and Utilization of Sangiran Area as World Cultural Heritage between the Ministry of Education and Culture, Central Java Provincial Government, Sragen Regency Government, and Karanganyar Regency Government have been issued in 2014. This MoU is an extension of the same MoU issued in 2009.</p> <p>In addition to the MoU, within the period of 2014 to 2015, there have been 4 (four) cooperation agreements between the management entity and other related governmental agencies on the protection, development, and utilization of Sangiran Early Man Site. Whilst during the period of 2015-2016, 4 (four) cooperation agreements with universities on education, research and community service have been issued.</p> <p>The completion of 2017 Management Plan signifies that the operation of the new integrated management structure of the Sangiran Early Man Site is on the right track. The issuance of cooperation agreements on each Factor to Manage as stipulated in the Management Plan underlines the commitment of the management entity to better manage the Site not only for the benefit of the Site itself but also for the inclusion and empowerment of the people who live in and around the Site. The cooperation agreements have been established between the management entity and among others, The Faculty of Cultural Sciences of the Universitas Gadjah Mada on the Education, Research, and Community Service. Several other cooperation agreements are still on progress, namely cooperation agreements between the management entity with Bank Indonesia as well as State University of Yogyakarta.</p>	B
