### TEXT

7. Endorses the draft “Policy Document on Climate Action for World Heritage”, as presented in Annex 1 of Document WHC/21/44.COM/7C, and requests the World Heritage Centre, in consultation with the Advisory Bodies, to revise it by incorporating views expressed at the 44<sup>th</sup> session and, as appropriate to consult Committee members, especially concerning the following points:-

- the fundamental principle of common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capabilities (CBDR-RC), which is one of the basic pillars of the international environmental regime;
- the alignment of climate mitigation actions to the CBDR-RC and the Nationally Determined Contributions accepted under the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement, except on an entirely voluntary basis;
- the necessity of support and capacity-building assistance, as well as the encouragement for technology transfer and financing, from developed to developing countries, in accordance with the CBDR-RC and in line with the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement.

Also recommends that the “Policy Document on Climate Action for World Heritage” be interpreted in consonance with the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), overarching framework of the Paris Agreement (2015) and the United Nations 2030 Agenda for sustainable development, and in conjunction with the Policy Document for integration of a sustainable development perspective into the processes of the World Heritage Convention (2015).
