The Silk Roads were an interconnected web of routes linking the ancient societies of Asia, the Subcontinent, Central Asia, Western Asia and the Near East. They contributed to the development of many of the world's great civilizations and represent one of the world's preeminent long-distance communication networks.

Project objectives:

The project, organized for the second time and utilizing an online-offline blended approach, aims at raising awareness about the history of the Silk Roads network. Designated the Secretariat of the *Coordinating Committee on Serial Transnational Nomination for World Heritage of the Silk Roads*, ICOMOS International Conservation Center - Xi'an aims at building a solid "reservoir" of knowledge about the Silk Roads for the current and future generations, across and beyond the countries and territories concerned.

The volunteers will contribute to editing, translating and sharing existing video lecture resources related to Silk Road cultural heritage, with the goal of building an international online free platform for promotion of the Silk Roads cultural heritage.
