



















Panel of experts: States Parties experts (active participants):

- 13 observers (incl. 2 per Electoral Group)









Panel's mandate



"Whether a property should be **inscribed on the World Heritage List** while knowing that its **potential Outstanding Universal Value may disappear** due to climate change impacts"








"Whether a property should be inscribed on the List of World Heritage in Danger or deleted from the World Heritage List due to impacts beyond the sole control of the concerned State Party"







"... for some natural and cultural properties, it will be **impossible to maintain the 'original' OUV** for which they were originally inscribed on the World Heritage List, even if effective adaptation and mitigation strategies are applied, and this may require an **'evolving' assessment of OUV**"





- Deforestation and other forms of land use change, unsustainable use of natural resources








States Parties' responsibilities

- Greater capacity-building for developing countries through commitments from developed countries (technology transfer and financing)








Adaptation

- Adaptation actions to increase the resilience of indigenous peoples and local communities








Implementation of the World Heritage Convention


