## 3. DATE AND PLACE OF THE 46TH SESSION OF THE WORLD HERITAGE COMMITTEE AND ELECTION OF THE BUREAU

#### Decision: 19 EXT.COM 3

The World Heritage Committee,

- 1. <u>Recalling</u> its Decision **45 COM 17**, adopted at its extended 45th session (Riyadh, 2023),
- 2. <u>Decides</u> that its 46th session will take place in India tentatively in July 2024, in accordance with Rule 4.1 of the Rules of Procedure<sup>1</sup>;
- 3. <u>Elects</u> in accordance with Rule 13.1 of the Rules of Procedure, its Bureau with the following composition:
  - Chairperson: H.E. Mr Vishal V. Sharma (India),
  - Vice-Chairpersons: Bulgaria, Greece, Kenya, Qatar, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines,
  - **Rapporteur**: Mr Martin Ouaklani (Belgium),

whose mandates will begin at the end of the 19th Extraordinary session of the Committee (UNESCO, 2023) until the end of the 46th session of the Committee (2024);

4. <u>Also decides</u> that the Bureau of the 47th session of the World Heritage Committee (2025) will be elected at the end of the 46th session of the World Heritage Committee (2024) in accordance with Rule 13.1 of the Rules of Procedure.
