As decided during the second meeting of the Open-ended Working Group in relation to Decision **45 COM 11** on 25 and 26 April 2024, States Parties will have the opportunity to make concrete and concise proposals in relation to the mandate of the Working Group. These proposals will be compiled in a document by the Secretariat to allow States Parties to work towards the development of recommendations to be transmitted to the World Heritage Committee at its forthcoming session.

To allow the completion of such a document, a succinct, focused bullet-point format is preferable and States Parties are invited to use the attached format to transmit their proposals to the Secretariat **preferably by 6 May 2024 and no later than 10 May**. Due to the very tight timeframe, written proposals received past this time will not be taken into account in that document and will be only uploaded on the dedicated webpage.
