1- Executive Summary:

The State Party (Libya) would like to express its gratitude to the World Heritage Committee (WHC) and its advisory bodies for the efforts and endeavors they have undertaken to monitor the status of the archaeological site of Cyrene (the property).

This report has been prepared in accordance with Annex 13 of the Operational Guidelines, in response to the decisions of the World Heritage Committee in its 46th session in New Delhi, India in 2024.

The Department of Antiquities (DOA) will continue to keep the WHC informed about the evolving status of the property and any new measures taken to ensure its protection and preservation, and provide detailed information on the work accomplished.

The Department of Antiquities and its office in Cyrene are diligently continuing the work of treating and mitigating the impact of storm Daniel (Sep 2023) in addition to the restoration of other monuments in the property.

The Department of Antiquities (DOA) would like to reiterate its invitation to a joint WHC/ICOMOS mission to assess the status of the property on-site and to provide advice to the Department of Antiquities.
