Point 8 de l'ordre du jour provisoire: Informations sur les listes indicatives

Ce document d'information fournit :

1. La liste des Etats parties qui ont soumis des listes indicatives de biens culturels répondant aux critères des Orientations devant guider la mise en oeuvre de la Convention du patrimoine mondial (paras 7& 8); et
2. Les listes indicatives individuelles soumises par ces Etats parties.

1. Lors de sa dix-septième session tenue à Carthagène en décembre 1993, le Comité a noté avec préoccupation le nombre limité de listes indicatives en conformité avec les paragraphes 7 et 8 des Orientations, et il a confirmé l'importance de ces listes pour la planification, l'analyse comparative des propositions d'inscription et la réalisation des études globales et thématiques. Ces listes constituent en outre un inventaire des biens situés sur le territoire de chaque Etat partie que ce dernier considère comme susceptibles d'être inscrits sur la Liste du patrimoine mondial (WHL). Le Comité a également confirmé que les listes indicatives sont obligatoires pour les biens culturels pour lesquels les Etats parties ont l'intention de soumettre des propositions d'inscription sur la Liste du patrimoine mondial dans les cinq à dix prochaines années.
2. En conséquence, le Comité a invité les Etats parties qui ne l'avaient pas encore fait à soumettre leurs listes indicatives conformément aux Orientations, étant entendu qu'"une assistance préparatoire sera fournie si nécessaire et à la demande de l'Etat partie concerné". Le Comité a également décidé que "à partir du 1er octobre 1995, seules les propositions d'inscription de biens culturels qui sont incluses dans les listes indicatives répondant à toutes les exigences formulées dans les Orientations, seront traitées".
3. Sur 147 pays ayant ratifié la Convention, seulement 67 Etats parties ont soumis des listes indicatives conformément aux critères spécifiés dans les Orientations (**Annexe I**).
4. Toutes les Listes indicatives individuelles reçues par le Centre du patrimoine mondial de ces Etats parties sont jointes en **Annexe I**, par ordre alphabétique anglais.
