Item 4 of the Provisional Agenda: Review of nominations to the World Heritage List and of requests for technical cooperation received from States Parties to the Convention

#### I. Nominations to the World Heritage List

- l. At its third session (October 1979), the Committee deferred a decision on three nominations to the World Heritage List. Furthermore, at the suggestion of the Bureau, the Committee did not examine twenty-six nominations on which the Bureau had been unable to formulate a recommendation. In the meantime, two of these nominations (Vingen N° 61 and Mølen N° 62) have been withdrawn by the Norvegian authorities. Twenty-seven nominations are hereby re-submitted to the Bureau for its consideration, together with the nomination of Edison National Historic Site which has been re-submitted by the United States of America. The twenty-eight nominations are listed below in section A.
- 2. Thirty-two new nominations from twelve countries were received by the Secretariat as at 1 January 1980, the deadline set by the Committee for the submission of nominations to be examined during 1980. These nominations, which are listed below in section B, are hereby submitted to the Bureau for consideration.

## A. Nominations deferred by the Committee and/or the Bureau

Cyprus

Paphos, Birthplace of Aphrodite

The Committee deferred this nomination until more precise information was available on the possible adverse impact on the site of tourism development. Additional information has been provided by the Cypriot authorities on this question and is submitted to the Bureau in the form of an addendum to the nomination form.

## Ghana Ashanti Traditional Buildings (N° 35)

This nomination was deferred because further documentation was required. Additional documentation is now available.

## Italy Convent of Santa Giulia - San Salvatore (N° 92)

The Committee deferred a decision on this nomination until indications had been received from the Italian Government on the properties situated in Italy which it was considering nominating to the List during the next five to ten years. No such indications have as yet been received by the Secretariat.

## The Historic Centre of Rome The Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci

These nominations were deferred until complementary information was received from the Italian authorities. The Secretariat has received no further data on these properties.

#### II. Requests for technical co-operation

## A. Requests on which the Bureau deferred its recommendation

#### 1. Ethiopia (request N° 18.1)

The Ethiopian Government had requested technical co-operation for the purpose of carrying out aphotogrammetric survey of the monuments of Lalibela. On the advice of ICCROM which considered that priority should be given to other conservation measures and the training of Ethiopian technicians, the Bureau deferred its recommendation. Training in architectural photogrammetry is now being organized for two Ethiopian nationals, and a revised request for technical co-operation is being prepared.

#### 2. Ethiopia (request N° 111.1)

The Ethiopian Government had requested aid amounting to \$63,500 in connection with the development of Bale Mountain National Park and for the specific purpose of enabling the authorities to carry out a comprehensive biological survey of the Mountain Nyala and the Semien Fox and their habitats. The Bureau deferred this request until it had had the opportunity to examine the nomination of the site to the World Heritage List. This request is submitted to the Bureau.

#### 3. Ethiopia (request N° 112.1)

A request had been received from the Ethiopian Government for assistance amounting to \$56,200 in connection with the development of Abijatta Shalla Lakes National Park and for the specific purpose of meeting the cost of a sociological survey needed to study the problem of resettling the population which had taken up residence within the park area. The Bureau deferred this request until it had had the opportunity to examine the nomination of the site to the World Heritage List. This request is submitted to the Bureau.

#### 4. Syrian Arab Republic (requests N° 20.1 -21.1 - 22.1 - 23.1)

The Syrian Government had requested equipment (cranes, lorries, jeeps, etc.) in connection with conservation work in Damascus, Aleppo, Bosra and Palmyra. Further clarifications are necessary with respect to the exact nature of the assistance required.

## B. New requests received by 1 January 1980

The following requests which all relate to properties included in the World Heritage List or nominated for inclusion therein have been received by the Secretariat.

## 5. Algeria (requests N° 101.1 - 102.1 - 103.1)

The Algerian authorities have submitted requests for assistance in connection with the preservation of the Dey's Palace, Qal'ah of Beni Hammad and the Citadel Quarter of Setif. These requests are submitted to the Bureau.

## 6. Nepal (request N° 120.1)

A request has been received from the Nepalese authorities for assistance amounting \$60,000 for conservation measures in Sagarmatha National Park. /to/ Bod ocur augments proqued \$75000

## 7. Tunisia (request N° 37.1)

The Tunisian Government is requesting aid amounting to approximately \$100,000 in connection with the preservation of the Baths of Antonius at Carthage. The funds requested are broken down as follows:
