## Item 7 of the Provisional Agenda: Guidelines for the evaluation of technical co-operation requests

At its fourth session (1-5 September 1980), the World Heritage Committee requested the Bureau "to elaborate guidelines for the evaluation of technical co-operation requests which then could be reviewed and adapted by the Committee."

In accordance with this request, the Secretariat drew up the following suggestions which are submitted to the Bureau for consideration.

Modifications are suggested below for paragraphs 45, 46, 47, 48 and 49 of the "Operational guidelines for the implementation of the World Heritage Convention".

45. States Parties can request technical co-operation for the following purposes:
