Item 7 of the Provisional Agenda: Requests for technical cooperation

Costa Rica (request n° 205.1 (2))

Financial contribution to activities related to strengthening the protection and management of Talamanca Range-La Amistad Reserves, amounting to \$50,000 including \$12,150 for training activities for 1985, and \$50,000 (including \$2,150 for training activities) for 1986.

Cuba (request n° 204.1)

Restoration material and equipment for the Plaza Vieja in Havana. The cost of this equipment which is being evaluated will be brought to the attention of the members of the Bureau.

Ecuador (request n° 260.1 (rev.1))

Financial contribution towards public awareness programmes for local communities and training of personnel in Sangay National Park for a total of US\$30,000.

Honduras (request n° 196.1(2))

Financial contribution to strengthen protection and management of Rio Platano Biosphere Reserve amounting to \$74,200 for 1985 (including \$4,000 for training) and \$73,500 for 1986 (including \$4,000 for training).

Panama (request n° 159.1(2))

Financial contribution to activities related to the management and protection of Darien National Park for a total of US\$50,000 (of which \$6,000 for training).

Sri Lanka (request n° 200.1)

Training of specialists and provision of equipment for the modernization of a conservation laboratory needed for the safeguarding of Anuradhapura, Polonnaruva and Sigiriya (\$101,000).

Yugoslavia (request n° 95.1)

Equipment for the observation of seismic phenomena for the safeguarding of the Old City of Dubrovnik (\$90,291).

Yugoslavia (request n° 100.1)

Equipment to study diseases of forest tree species in Durmitor National Park (\$60,000)

Zaire (request n° 280.1)

Equipment to strengthen protection and surveillance of Salonga National Park (nominated for inclusion in the World Heritage List) and support to training of research personnel: \$ 107,180 of which \$42,000 requested for training and \$65,180 for equipment.

Zaire (request n° 281.1)

Equipment to strengthen protection and surveillance of Maïko National Park (nominated for inclusion in the World Heritage List) and support to training of research personnel: \$102,890 of which \$42,000 requested for training.

Zaire (request n° 282.1)

Equipment to strengthen protection and surveillance of Upemba National Park (nominated for inclusion in the World Heritage List) and support to training of research personnel: \$107,180 of which \$42,000 requested for training.

Zaire (request n° 283.1)

Equipment to strengthen protection and surveillance of Kundelungu National Park (nominated for inclusion in the World Heritage List) and support to training of research personnel: \$108,480 of which \$42,000 requested for training.
