Costa Rica (request No. 205.1(3)

Financial contribution towards improvement of infrastructure, transportation, purchase of basic equipment, rural ecodevelopment activities and boundary surveys, amounting to \$20,000, for Talamanca-La Amistad Reserves. These activities form part of a long-term project to develop this World Heritage site for which there is also a request for \$20,000 support to the training activities (on site workshops, in-service training in the Rio Platano World Heritage Site, etc.) which are associated with this project. Total requested for 1986 amounts therefore to \$40,000.

Panama (request No. 159.1(3)

Financial contribution to improvement of infrastructure, environmental education programme and rural extension activities in Darien National Park amounting to \$40,000. These activities form part of an ongoing project for which their is an annual national contribution of approximately \$80,000 and bi-national and multi-national support amounting annually to \$45,000.
