Tentative lists of cultural and natural properties received since the eleventh session of the World Heritage Committee

- 1. Since the eleventh session of the Committee, the Secretariat has received tentative lists of cultural properties from Egypt, Iraq, Mali, the Sultanate of Oman, Saudi Arabia, the Syrian Arab Republic and Tunisia. Tentative lists of cultural and natural properties were also received from Cuba and Nigeria. This brings the number of States parties having submitted tentative lists to 39 (see Annex 1).
- 2. The Working Group set up by the Committee at its eleventh session examined the question of tentative lists. Its conclusions are reflected in paragraph 11 of document SC-88/CONF.001/2 entitled "Report of the Working Group established by the Committee at its eleventh session", as well as in paragraphs 7-9 of the Operational Guidelines for the implementation of the World Heritage Convention as modified by the Working Group (see document SC-88/CONF.001/3 entitled "Revision of Operational Guidelines").
- 3. The tentative lists received since the eleventh session of the Committee will be at the disposal of States members for consultation.
