21B. Costed, time-bound budget for a new series of World Heritage Resource Manuals

SUMMARY

Following Decisions **30 COM 6** (paragraph 6) and **30 COM 15.2** (paragraph 4) which requested the Director of the World Heritage Centre to prepare a costed, time-bound budget for a new series of World Heritage Resource Manuals and present it for discussion at the 31st session in 2007, this document presents a preliminary list of titles in the series and an estimated budget.

Draft Decision: 31 COM 21B, see point IV.

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. Decision **30 COM 6** (paragraph 6) welcomed the proposal by the Advisory Bodies and the World Heritage Centre to produce a series of World Heritage Resource Manuals to provide focused guidance on the implementation of the *World Heritage Convention* and requested the Director of the World Heritage Centre to prepare a costed, time-bound budget for this new series for discussion at the 31st session in 2007.
- 2. Decision **30 COM 15.2** (paragraph 4) also requested the Director of the World Heritage Centre to prepare a costed, time-bound budget for a new series of World Heritage Resource Manuals for discussion at the 31st session in 2007.
- 3. The Resource Manuals are intended to respond to a much-identified need to provide a core set of best practice guidelines for the implementation of the *Convention* to practitioners and policy-makers alike.
- 4. Since the 30th session of the Committee (Vilnius, 2006), this issue has been discussed at two meetings between the Advisory Bodies and the World Heritage Centre, in September 2006 and in January 2007. A preliminary list of titles was discussed and established, as well as the time frame for their publication and the budget. Preliminary layout proposals for different covers and sample inside pages were prepared and presented by the World Heritage Centre. The format and design of the *Basic Texts* publication was taken as a basis in order to highlight the link with the *Convention*. The final layout remains to be decided upon at a forthcoming meeting between the World Heritage Centre and the Advisory Bodies.

II. PRELIMINARY LIST OF TITLES

5. The publications marked with an asterisk are planned for publication during the 2008/09 biennium and their budget is presented for approval by the 31st session of the Committee. The other titles are presented in a non-chronological order and are not listed by priority. Their preparation and their budgets will be presented at forthcoming Committee sessions.

A. Guidance on Preparing World Heritage Nominations*

 IUCN has prepared the draft concerning natural nominations and is currently undergoing field testing. ICOMOS and ICCROM will provide their input by September 2007. A harmonization, editing and translation process will precede the production of the publication, planned for July 2008. The detailed budget and timetable are given below, under III.

B. Guidance on Conservation and Management of World Heritage Properties

- 7. A number of separate titles dedicated to conservation and management issues for different types of sites are envisaged, as follows:
 - Preparing Management Plans for Natural World Heritage Properties*

The IUCN draft publication is in its field-testing phase and the printing is planned for February 2008. The detailed budget and timetable are given below.

• Preparing Management Plans for Cultural World Heritage Properties*

ICOMOS and ICCROM are working jointly on this publication whose finalization is planned for April 2009. The detailed budget and timetable are given below.

• Tourism and World Heritage Resource Manual*

Present to World Heritage site managers and States Parties lessons learned since 2001 when the Tourism Programme was officially recognized by the World Heritage Committee and the recommended processes for a number of tourism-related interventions.
