A request for emergency assistance amounting to US\$100,000 has been received from Ecuador for the most urgent work required for the restoration of monuments in the Historic Centre of Quito damaged by the earthquake which struck on 5-6 March 1987. A consultant who evaluated the damage caused by the earthquake has estimated the total cost of restoration work on the monuments of Quito to be of the order of US\$6 million. The Bureau may wish to consider already allocating at its present session US\$30,000. A request for additional funding will be submitted to the Committee at its next session.

2) Honduras

Consultant services, training of local staff, purchase of two four-wheel drive vehicles, a passenger car and photographic and audio-visual equipment for improving the protection of Rio Plátano World Heritage site. A total amount of US\$114,576 is requested for the period June 1987 to May 1989, of which US\$30,000 is sought under emergency assistance, and the balance, i.e., US\$84,576, under large-scale technical cooperation.
